## God's Divine Plan

<p><b>AUTHORITY</b> "Yielded Control"</p>	<p>God wants young people who will radically dedicate their lives to His loving Lordship and obediently submit to the authority of His Word, His Spirit and His representatives. Rev. 12:11; Heb. 13:17; Eph. 6:1-3 <i>"He who loses his life for My sake will find it."</i> -- Matt. 10:39</p>
<p><b>LOVE</b> "Selfless Giving"</p>	<p>Those who are truly freed from the bondage of sin and rebellion can experience the covenant relationships and pure affection of the Body of Christ, and learn to serve each other in love as brothers and sisters. Gal. 5:13-16, 22-26; 1 Tim. 5:1-2 <i>"Love one another fervently with a pure heart."</i> --1 Peter 1:22</p>
<p><b>POWER</b> "Demonstrated Faith"</p>	<p>When a young believer experiences the supernatural manifestation of the Holy Spirit's power, it makes all other counterfeits cheap and temporal and introduces him to a new realm of faith. Acts 1:8; Acts 8:9-19; 1 Cor. 2:4-5 <i>"The kingdom of God is not in word, but in power."</i> -- 1 Cor. 4:20</p>
<p><b>TRUTH</b> "Ultimate Reality"</p>	<p>The Lord is raising up a generation of young men and women whose minds have been renewed by the reality and truth of His Word, and whose lifestyles reflect the superior principles of the Holy Scriptures. 2 Tim 3:6-4:5; 2 Thess. 2:9-17 <i>"The truth shall make you free."</i> -- John 8:32</p>
<p><b>WORSHIP</b> "Loving God"</p>	<p>God is seeking a generation to worship Him. Only when we worship Him in spirit and in truth can we know what it means to love the Lord our God with all our heart, soul, mind and strength. John 4:23-24; Luke 24:50-53; Phil. 3:3 <i>"You shall worship the Lord your God, and Him only."</i> -- Matt. 4:10</p>

## The Enemy's Plot

<p><b>REBELLION</b> "The Search for Security"</p>	<p>Satan takes advantage of young people's reaction to human authority and out of their hurt and hatred stirs a spirit of rebellion against the authority of God. 1 Sam. 15:23; Matt. 10:39; Eph. 2:1-3 In the last days: <i>"Disobedient to parents."</i> -- 2 Tim. 3:2</p>
<p><b>IMMORALITY</b> "The Search for Affection"</p>	<p>Looking for attention, affection and meaningful relationships, young people often fall into Satan's trap of deceitful desires and sexual immorality. 1 Cor. 6:9-7:2; Gal. 5:13-6:9; 1 Thess 4:1-10 In the last days: <i>"Without self-control, lovers of pleasure."</i> -- 2 Tim. 3:3-4</p>
<p><b>SORCERY</b> "The Search for the Supernatural"</p>	<p>Every young person hungers for spiritual reality and desires to experience the world of the supernatural. Drugs and alcohol are artificial attempts to find that world which open the soul to satanic influence. Rev. 18:23; Acts 8:9-25; Acts 13:6-12 In the last days: <i>"Having a form of godliness, but denying its power."</i> -- 2 Tim. 3:5</p>
<p><b>FANTASY</b> "The Search for Reality"</p>	<p>Today's hyper-interest in mythology and science fiction is a prophetic fulfillment of the Scriptures and a subtle but powerful distraction to the minds of a younger generation. 2 Tim 4:2-4; 1 Tim. 1:3-7; 1 Tim. 4:6-7 In the last days: <i>"Turned aside to fables."</i> -- 2 Tim. 4:4</p>
<p><b>IDOLATRY</b> "The Search for a God"</p>	<p>Satan uses dynamic and beautiful music to arouse desire in young people that manifests itself in the idolatrous worship of people or things, deceiving young people into actually worshipping Satan. Exodus 32; Amos 6:3-6; Daniel 3 In the last days: <i>"Lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God."</i> - 2 Tim. 3:4</p>
